



Our meeting is a work-sharing meeting between people who speak the same language but who live in different places and have different cultures and traditions, which give an endearing richness.

We must start from the fact that our life, in a certain way, is a way of wandering, because we constantly make mistakes along the way, and because of the unknown, and the real mystery that living is.. But imperfection and clumsiness challenge us to have a sensitive regard, , from the most intimate, to both, joy and suffering. Life challenges us as to be a PRESENCE. And WE must be the word to make us live together. The others are not before me but in me. There must be the change of perspective: internalize the other, how? In everyday life, in all gestures and any everyday moments.

We should be artisans, or builders of care, care for the different, care for the foreigner; Caring as a way of living. Caring should be synonymous with CITIZENSHIP. We want all to be involved, even to reach political participation and to carry a message of protecting the common good, of sharing common goods such as water and nature, but also space, time and the common knowledge of our culture. We bet on learning a collaborative and sustainable way of life, on being the visible face of openness. To do this, let's remove the barrier of our PREJUDICES that paralyze, accuse and judge others and ourselves. It is necessary to listen to the other first. And, above all, take care of childhood, as a power of the new, power of hope, through a pedagogy of the senses, taking care of their spare time where playing contributes to exercise thinking. Thus, Children will become adults who take into account the relation to creation and promote the common good.

To achieve this, , let us take care of our present moment, today, now, it this what we have and what that makes us important in order to build a good future. But, always, let us live life in the present continuous, as the best prayer of gratefulness.




BE A BRIDGE
